## THREE EAGLE CHARTERS

## SAFETY ORIENTATION

- 1. <u>LIFE VEST</u>: Located forward, in the "life jacket" labeled compartment at the foot of bed. (8 adult & 2 children). In an emergency, the closest person will hand out vests, all persons will don a vest, help the children, then follow the Captain's instructions.
- 2. <u>LIFE RING</u>: Located overhead on deck, starboard side above doorway. A 60-foot lifeline is attached. In the event of a person overboard, maintain constant visual contact, alert the Captain and throw the ring buoy if the person is close enough to reach it.
- 3. <u>LIFE RAFT</u>: An 8-person raft is located on the bridge. It is automatic self-deploying, or manual. Do not use this unit as a seat while viewing from the bridge.
- 4. EPIRB: Electronic satellite locator beacon for emergency use only, next to the exit.
- 5. <u>FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:</u> 4 extinguishers, one in forward berth next to the galley, one in aft berth across from the galley, one in salon below the helm station and one automatic halon is located in the engine room.
- 6. <u>RADIOS, CELLPHONE</u>: VHF Marine Radio (gray) overhead at helm, CB Radio (black) overhead at helm. Cell Phone located at helm. VHF instructions on yellow card located at helm, also on a placard mounted next to the radio.
- 7. <u>FLARES:</u> Located in bright orange plastic containers located in salon. Load the flare launcher <u>only</u> out on an open deck. Do not fire flares unless another vessel is close enough to see them or unless instructed to do so by the Captain or the Coast Guard.
- 8. FIRST AID KIT: Located in the head (bathroom) below the sink.
- VESSEL OPERATION & DOCKING PROCEDURES: Only the Captain and crew will operate the vessel or assist with docking procedures. However, during an emergency you may be assigned a task.
- 10. <u>TEAMWORK</u>: The key to handling any emergency situation is clear thinking and teamwork. Do not panic and become an additional burden to the situation. Follow the Captain's instructions, as well as keeping the Captain informed of any perceived or potentially dangerous events or situations you may see developing.
- 11. HEALTH: Does anyone have any health considerations I should be aware of? This is a non-smoking vessel. A trashcan is located by the door. Nothing goes overboard.
- 12. <u>CAPTAIN EMERGENCY:</u> In the event the Captain becomes incapacitated or falls overboard, STOP THE VESSEL, RENDER ASSISTANCE, & CALL FOR HELP, in that order. Further instructions are available on the YELLOW card at the helm.
- 13. <u>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:</u> Emergency checklist location. Swim step and front deck is off limits. Flybridge limited to 3 persons over 13 years of age. No food or drink on bridge, no smoking, no alcohol, wave action caution, toilet instructions, stow extra gear, binoculars & books, fish hook caution, drinks in a holder.
- 14. <u>CHILDREN</u>: Parents maintain control of children at all times. No horseplay or running. Please limit their sweets and exploring the vessel. Kids remain in the Salon area only. Assist them with bathroom if needed. Children under 13 must have a life jacket on at <u>all</u> times when outside the cabin door.
