- History -

The first Capital to Capital Race, 908 miles from Olympia to Juneau, was held in 1928. The 50th anniversary of the race, renamed the International Cruiser Race, was held in 1978. This may well be the father of predicted log races for powerboats and was the longest motor-boat contest ever run on the American continent.

The current Juneau Yacht Club was organized in the early 1940's and was officially incorporated in 1955. In 1947, a small house was moved to Harris Harbor and became a small restaurant and meeting place for the Club. That building was sold in 1973.

Through the efforts of Leroy West, Ken Morgan, and Don Statter, in 1975 construction began on a new clubhouse on the present site at the north end of Aurora Harbor.

Most of the interior finish was performed by member volunteers under the supervision of Ralph Graham. Several building upgrades have occurred and are continuing.

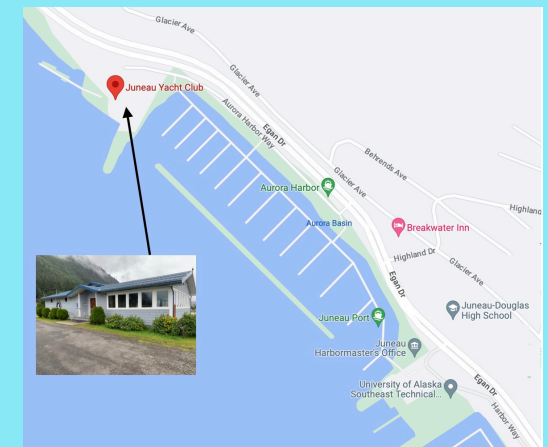
